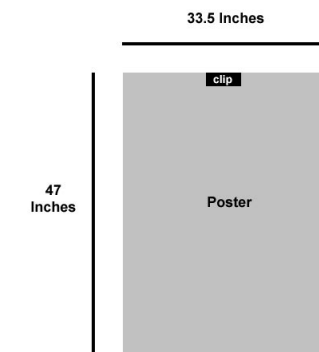


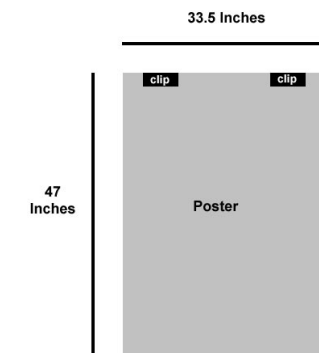


Mounting Instructions for Denmark, October 1943 Exhibition

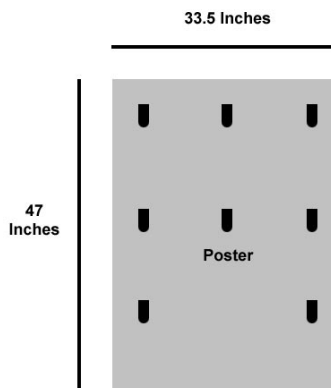
The following are the ways we suggest for mounting the posters. Please remember that while mounting, you will be held responsible for any damages incurred to the posters. Each poster is 33 ½ “ wide and 47” tall. There are 36 posters in the exhibit, and there is one additional donor board that is 24” wide and 36” tall. We request that the donor board be displayed prominently. Thank you very much for your cooperation.



1. This is the mounting diagram for an easel mount. The poster can be mounted on the easel by a single center clip. Please make sure that there is padding on the clip to ensure that no damage is incurred to the poster.



2. This is the mounting diagram for a hanging mount. The poster can be mounted from a ceiling, a beam, or a wall. Two separate pieces of wire can be attached from the stationary object (such as ceiling etc) and secured to the poster, each with a clip. Please make sure that there is padding on the clips to ensure that no damage is incurred to the poster.



3. This is the mounting diagram to directly mount the posters onto a wall. Please use eight 3M Command strips as indicated in the diagram. Please follow directions on the 3M packaging. These Command strips can be purchased at Staples office supply store, item number MMM17024.
